



**ARRA GREEN JOBS TRAINING:  
GREEN CAPACITY BUILDING GRANT AWARDS**



**Green Capacity Building Overview**

On November 18, 2009, U.S. Secretary of Labor Hilda L. Solis announced approximately \$5.8 million in Green Capacity Building grants, as authorized by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The Green Capacity Building Grants will increase the training capacity of 62 current Labor Department grant recipients through a variety of strategies, and will offer training opportunities to help individuals acquire jobs in expanding green industries.

The Green Capacity Building grant program is intended to build the green training capacity of current Department of Labor grantees. Through these grants, the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) will help individuals acquire the skills needed to enter and advance in green industries and occupations by building the capacity of active DOL-funded training programs. Grantees will provide education and training in the skills and competencies that are needed in green industries and occupations, and may bolster the capacity of their training programs through staff professional development, curriculum development, partnership development, the purchase of equipment, and where necessary, the hiring of additional staff.
