<i>Step 3: Calculate the Weighted Veteran Numerator: (Veteran Numerator = 1,025) + (Veteran Receiving Intensive Services Weighting Factor = 53) = Weighted Veteran Numerator =</i>				1,078
<i>Step 4: Calculate the Weighted Veteran EER: (Weighted Veteran Numerator = 1078) / (Veteran Denominator = 1,450) = Weighted Veteran EER =</i>				74%*
